**Findings of Fact**

After review of the file and related materials submitted with regard to the above noted application, pursuant to Title 38, Maine Revised Statutes (M.R.S.) § 590 and 06-096 Code of Maine Rules (C.M.R.) ch. 115, the Maine Department of Environmental Protection (the Department) finds the following facts:

**I. Registration**

Cando Rail & Terminals (U.S.) LLC has requested the transfer of Air Emission License A-702-71-K-R from Savage Services Corporation to Cando Rail & Terminals (U.S.) LLC through a letter to the Department dated May 12, 2026. Air Emission License A-702-71-K-R was issued to Savage Services Corporation on October 2, 2023. The facility is a bulk material handling facility.

The equipment addressed in the license is located at 123 Rodman Rd, Auburn, Maine.

All rules, regulations, or statutes referenced in this air emission license refer to the amended version in effect as of the issued date of this license.

**II. Transfer Requirements**

A. Title, Right, or Interest

In their application, Cando Rail & Terminals (U.S.) LLC submitted copies of property deeds transferring ownership of the facility to Cando Rail & Terminals (U.S.) LLC. The parties have provided sufficient evidence of title, right, or interest in the facility to allow the transfer of the facility's licenses.

B. Technical Capacity and Intent

Cando Rail & Terminals (U.S.) LLC's acquisition of the facility is not expected to result in any significant change in the employees who currently operate the equipment and facilities and conduct activities relative to the air emission license. The facility's regulatory history with the Department demonstrates that the environmental personnel are competent in air pollution control. The information submitted in the application provides sufficient evidence that Cando Rail &

Cando Rail & Terminals (U.S.) LLC certifies that there will be no increase in air emissions beyond that provided for in the existing air emission license, either in quantity or type.


**Order**
