## **Findings of Fact**

After review of the file and related materials submitted with regard to the above noted application, pursuant to Title 38, Maine Revised Statutes (M.R.S.) § 590 and 06-096 Code of Maine Rules (C.M.R.) ch. 115, the Maine Department of Environmental Protection (the Department) finds the following facts:

### **I. Registration**

Boise Cascade Building Materials Distribution, L.L.C. (Boise Cascade) has requested the transfer of Air Emission License A-1171-71-A-N from Brockway-Smith Company to Boise Cascade through a letter to the Department dated May 29, 2026. Air Emission License A-1171-71-A-N was issued to Brockway-Smith Company on August 10, 2023. The facility is a building supply warehouse.

This license completes the processing of the application with the following submission number as assigned by the Department: 603621 (accepted June 17, 2026).

All rules, regulations, or statutes referenced in this air emission license refer to the amended version in effect as of the issued date of this license.

### **II. Transfer Requirements**

#### **A. Title, Right, or Interest**

In their application, Boise Cascade submitted copies of merger documents transferring ownership of the facility to Boise Cascade. The parties have provided sufficient evidence of title, right, or interest in the facility to allow the transfer of the facility's license.

#### **B. Technical Capacity and Intent**

Boise Cascade's acquisition of the facility is not expected to result in any significant change in the employees who currently operate the equipment and facilities and conduct activities relative to the air emission license. The facility's regulatory history with the Department demonstrates that the environmental personnel are competent in air pollution control. The information submitted in the application

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provides sufficient evidence that Boise Cascade has the technical capacity and intent to comply with their air emission license.

**C. Full Name and Address**

**D. Certification**

Boise Cascade certifies that there will be no increase in air emissions beyond that provided for in the existing licenses, either in quantity or type.

**Order**

Based on the above, the Department concludes that the applicant for the air emission license transfer has the capacity to satisfy all applicable statutory criteria and hereby approves the transfer of Air Emission License A-1171-71-A-N, from Brockway-Smith Company to Boise Cascade, subject to all conditions attached to it.

Severability. The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of this License Transfer or part thereof shall not affect the remainder of the provision or any other provisions. This License Transfer shall be construed and enforced in all respects as if such invalid or unenforceable provision or part thereof had been omitted.
