## 2024-2025 Healthcare Worker Influenza Vaccination Report

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP), and the Healthcare Infection Control Practices Advisory Committee (HICPAC) recommend that all U.S. healthcare workers (HCW) get vaccinated annually against influenza. Maine state law (22 M.R.S. § 802) requires that healthcare facilities report data on seasonal influenza vaccine coverage among HCW in their facilities annually to the Maine CDC.

The 2024-2025 HCW Influenza Vaccination Survey was completed for the reporting period of September 1, 2024 through May 31, 2025. The vaccination data reported by all facility types was analyzed and a summary table was generated (Table 1). Hospital specific data was analyzed separately and a graphical representation of these results by individual hospital can be found on the last page (Figure 2).

The State average for vaccine coverage in the 2024-2025 influenza season for healthcare workers among all facility types was 94.8% showing an increase of 2.1% from the 2023-2024 season (92.7%). Influenza rates among hospital specific facilities have also increased from 96.6% (2023-2024 season) to 97.8% (2024-2025 season) which is attributed to more complete record keeping, seasonal influenza campaigns, and quality improvement measures.

Vaccination is the most effective and efficient way to ensure that healthcare workers, their family members and patients, particularly those who are immunocompromised, are protected against seasonal influenza. This is perhaps one of the most important reasons why it would be advantageous for facilities to meet all requirements of the Maine Immunization Healthcare Workers law and to help reach the goal of the Maine Immunization Program to bring the State vaccine coverage rate average for influenza to 100%.

Figure 1: Influenza Immunization Rates by Facility Type

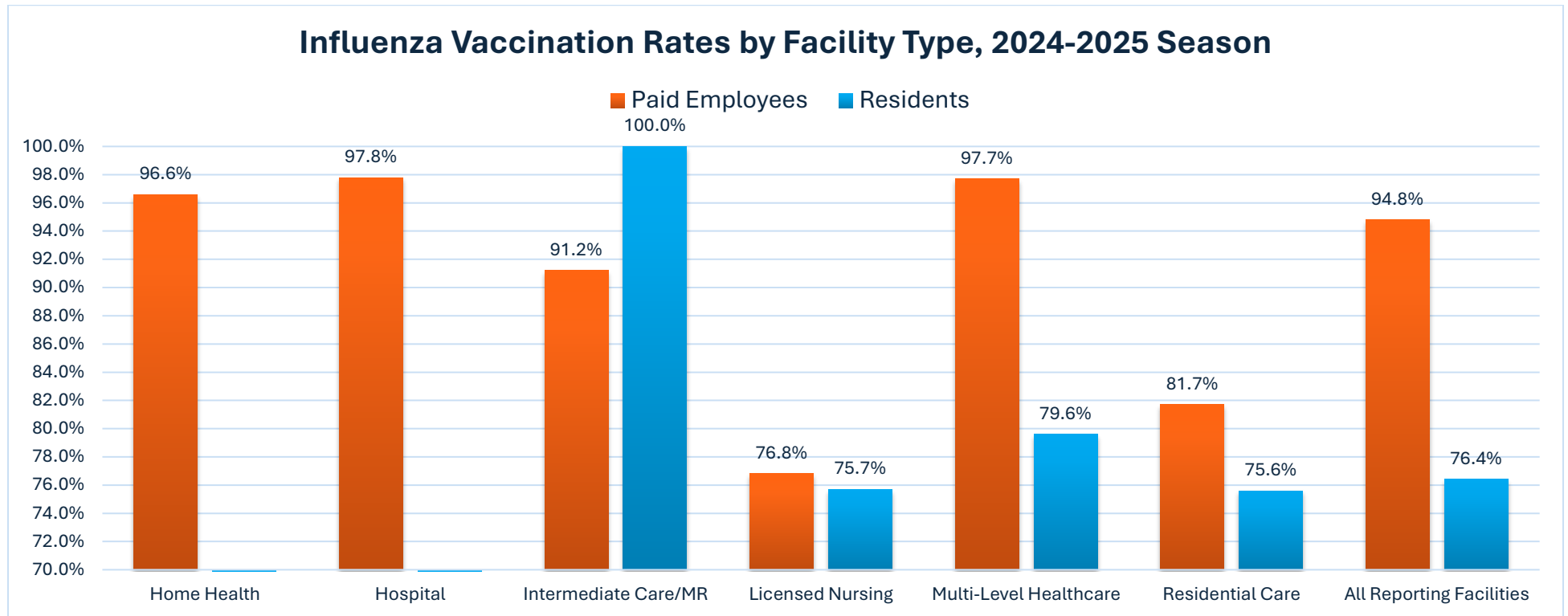
