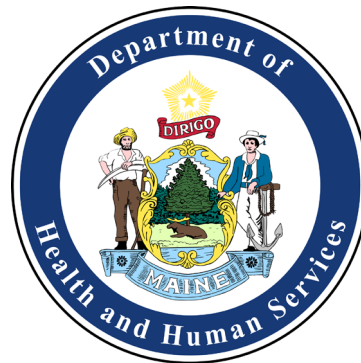

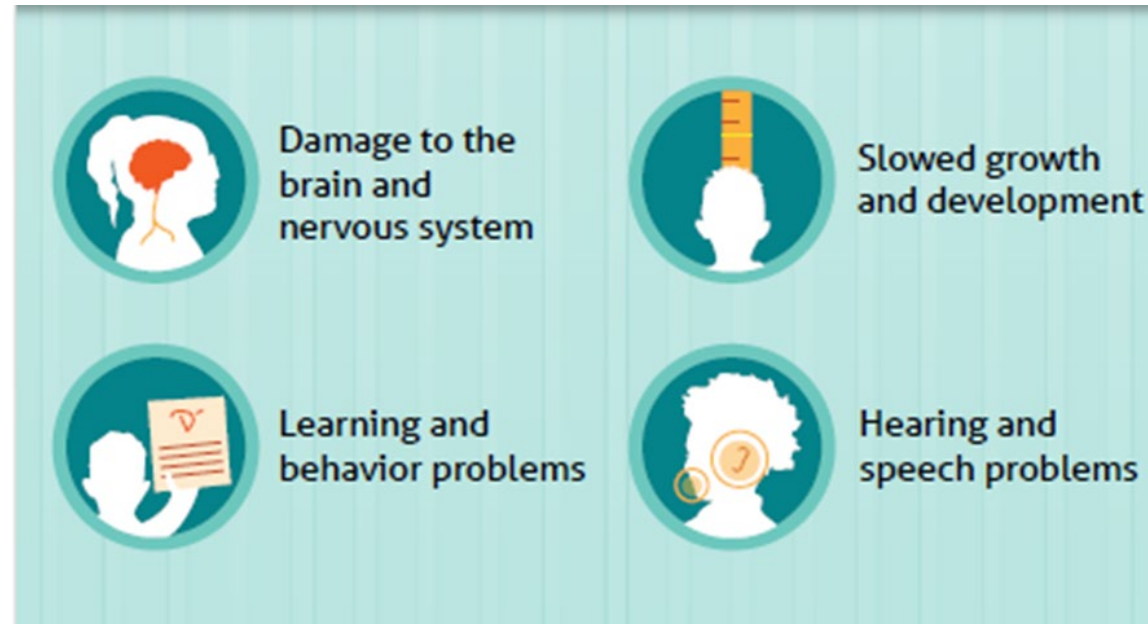

Health Effects of Lead in Children

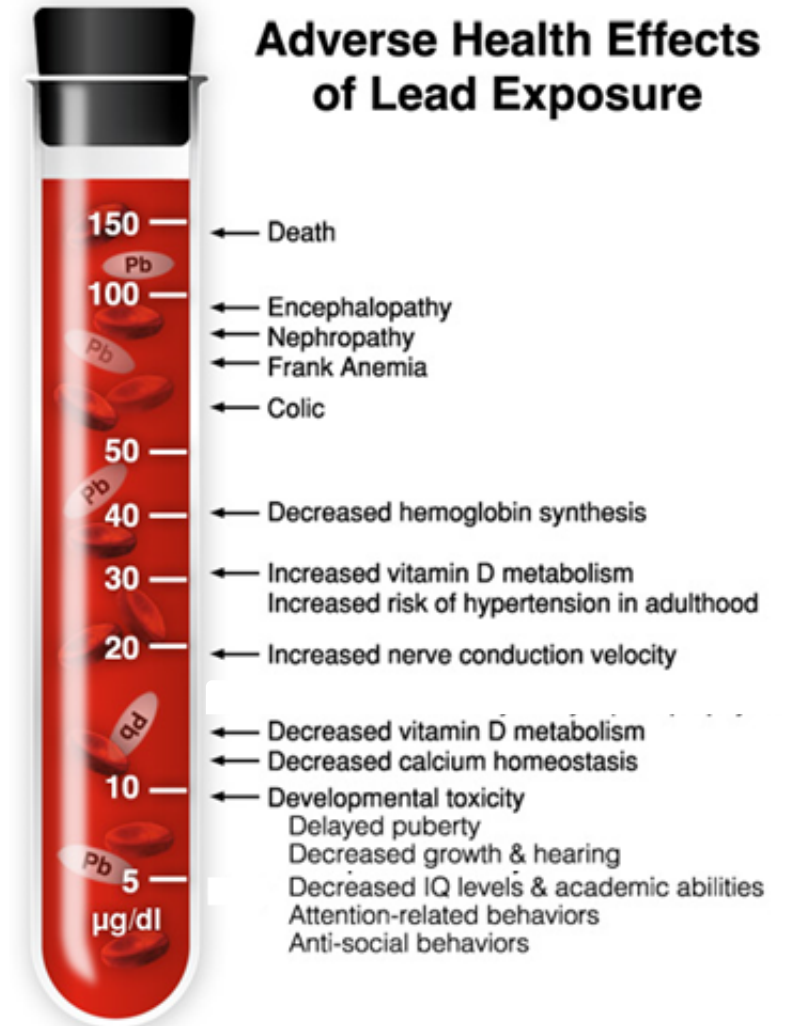
- Even low blood levels of lead place children at risk for adverse health effects.



- In 2024, an estimated 368 Maine children under age 6 had blood lead levels above 5 mg/dL.

Health Effects of Lead in Children

While rare, at higher blood levels of lead, children are at risk for additional health effects, including seizures, coma and death at very high levels.



Which Children are at risk for lead poisoning?

Children living in homes built before 1950 are at highest risk for lead exposure. Deteriorated lead paint and resulting lead dust pose the greatest risk, but even intact paint may be a risk for some children.



Other Risk Factors for Lead Poisoning

- Children whose parents work in lead related industries are at risk from “take home” lead.
- Lead from plumbing sources may contaminate drinking water.
- Some cultural or dietary practices may expose children to lead.



DHHS Provides Services Based on “Confirmed” Blood Lead Levels $\geq 5 \mu\text{g/dL}$

- Children may be screened for lead poisoning with either a capillary or a venous blood test.
- Capillary tests are more likely than venous tests to be contaminated from lead on the child’s skin or from the testing environment.
- Providers should confirm all capillary blood lead levels 3.5 $\mu\text{g/dL}$ or higher with a venous sample to determine if a child actually has lead poisoning according to Maine’s definition.

$\mu\text{g/dL}$ = micrograms per deciliter

Universal Blood Lead Testing Mandate 2019

Recognizing the importance of identifying children with lead poisoning in order to provide them with DHHS services to reduce their lead exposure, in 2019, the Maine State Legislature mandated that health care providers test all 1- and 2-year-olds for lead poisoning.

Role of Providers

- Test all 1- and 2-year-olds for blood lead.
- Follow Maine CDC guidelines for testing at 3, 4, and 5 years.
- Confirm elevated capillary results.
- Follow-up elevated venous results to make certain DHHS actions have been successful in reducing blood lead levels.

More on Blood Lead History

- Daily, Maine CDC uploads all venous blood lead tests and capillary tests analyzed at Maine Health and Environmental Testing Lab
- You cannot enter test results unless your organization is approved for in-office testing.
- Providers who perform in-office capillary testing must enter results into ImmPact within 48 hours of test.
- Only Maine CDC staff can change blood lead test results once they are saved in ImmPact.
